#### 1 Review

- a. The proposal entitled Review of Interim University of Maryland Policy and Procedures on Hazing, V-1.00(K)
- b. The policy entitled *University of Maryland Policy and Procedures on Hazing*, <u>V-1.00(K)</u>
- c. The H.R.5656-Stop Campus Hazing Act
- d. Similar policies and procedures on Hazing at Big 10 and other peer institutions.

### 2. Consult

- a. Office of Student Conduct
- b. Office of Fraternity & Sorority Life
- c. University of Maryland Police Department (UMPD)
- d. With student groups including, but not limited to, the University Senate Student Affairs Committee, SGA, GSG, and RHA, to solicit feedback on the interim policy.

## 3. Consider

- a. If the proposed policy is in alignment with the requirements of the "Stop Campus Hazing Act"
- b. If there is alignment with other UMD policies (e.g., Code of Student Conduct)
- c. If the proposed policy language is clear and concise
- d. If the proposed hazing reporting procedures are easy to follow and provide the appropriate resources
- 4. Consult with a representative from the Office of General Counsel on any proposed changes to the University's policy.
- 5. If appropriate, recommend whether the policy should be revised and if so, provide suggested revisions.
